Gold Skink/Ground Skink

Common Name: Gold Skink

Scientific Name: *Mabuya multifasciata*

General Info: The Gold Skink is from Southeast Asia and generally grows up to nine inches in length. Males tend to be very territorial and are usually more colorful than females.

Temperature: Daily temperatures should range between 75 to 92 degrees Fahrenheit. Humidity should be provided by placing a dish filled with water into the terrarium.

Lighting: Gold Skinks require full spectrum lighting and U.V. radiation.

Feeding/Watering: These skinks are fed crickets, mealworms, and other insects. Fresh water is also needed at all times.

Habitat/Housing: A twenty gallon sized terrarium is recommended for housing three or four of these Gold Skinks. Landscape by creating shelters with select cork bark slabs, driftwood, rocks, etc.

Other Info: Other North American, African, and Asian Ground Skinks can be maintained in the same way.
