MISSION STATEMENT

“To provide a drug and alcohol free community to ensure continuing sobriety and recovery through the 12 steps”

WHO WE ARE:

Women In Transition, a non-profit corporation, is a recovery house in Northeastern Indiana established for women who want to overcome their addictions to alcohol and drugs.

We are here to serve any woman who has an honest desire to recover, with special emphasis to the women of Steuben, Lagrange, Noble, And Dekalb counties.

Our Board of Directors are local area residents who are committed to seeing that women in this community have a resource to turn to help them recover.

With the financial support of the community, and the receipt of grant monies, we opened our house in October 2003. We are not associated with any sect, denomination, or government agency.

Our home is a safe haven for women to learn to live clean and sober. Our goal is to return women to our community, as active, contributing members.

WHO WE ARE ASSOCIATED WITH:

Drug Free Indiana, through Steuben, Lagrange, Noble, and Dekalb Counties, Interagency Group for Steuben County, Dual Diagnosis Committee of Steuben County.

We are members of the National Association of Halfway House Alcohol Programs of North America.

OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR:

Lindi Marti has been sober over 16 years; received her Bachelor of Science degree from Tri-State University; has 10 years of management experience in the private sector; volunteered in a women's prison and served on the Board of Directors of another recovery house. Lindi and her family live on the premises and provide stable role models for the recovering women residents.

WHAT WE ASK OF OUR RESIDENTS:

- Women who wish to come to Women In Transition are required to be clean and sober for 48 hours prior to admittance.
- Women are required to complete an application and comply with our agreement for admittance.

- Residents must remain clean and sober at all times.
- Residents are required to attend 12-step and house meetings as stated in the agreement for admittance.
- Residents are required to pay one week's rent prior to admittance.
- Residents are required to obtain employment.
- Residents are required to complete chores and comply with house curfews.
- Women who come to Women In Transition will learn to be responsible for themselves and to others.
